The Opportunities

2 Research Directors:

Reporting to the Vice President, Research and Analysis, the Research Director will provide overall leadership and oversight for the design, development and delivery of major research initiatives of the Institute within one of two core workstreams; Adaption and Mitigation. The successful applicant will have at least 8 years of relevant experience in policy analysis with a proven track record in scoping and implementing policy research using both quantitative and qualitative approaches. This experience will illustrate increasing responsibility. The successful applicant will also be an excellent communicator and writer, capable of distilling complex ideas into simple, accessible language. In addition, the applicant will demonstrate the ability to build successful relationships with a diverse group of stakeholders including internal colleagues, a network of partner organizations, governments, and communities. This role provides leadership to two Research Associates.

Salary range: \$100,000 - \$135,000 commensurate with qualifications and experience.

3 Senior Research Associates:

Reporting to and under the guidance of the Research Director, the Senior Research Associate will lead assigned research projects, developing outlines and executing work plans including identifying and implementing appropriate methodologies in answering key research questions. The successful applicant will have demonstrated over a minimum of 5 years, core policy research experience and results, including literature review, data synthesis and analysis. The candidate will also demonstrate excellent writing skills and a track record of successful contribution to communication and engagement activities in support of research delivery.

Salary range: \$80,000 - \$100,000 commensurate with qualifications and experience.

3 Research Associates:

Reporting to the Research Director, the Research Associate will support both the Director and the Senior Research Associate in executing individual research projects, including contributing to the development of work plans, conducting literature reviews, and providing core data synthesis and analysis. The successful candidate will demonstrate over a minimum of 2 years, increasing research skills and aptitude, including strong writing skills.

Salary range: \$50,000 - \$80,000 commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Additional Details Common to the Three Roles

- Master's Degree in Public Policy, Economics, Resource Management, or other field of study if combined with relevant policy research experience.
- Location open for discussion as The Institute will have offices across the country.
- These roles are full-time salaried positions.
- Bilingual (French and English) skill is an asset.
