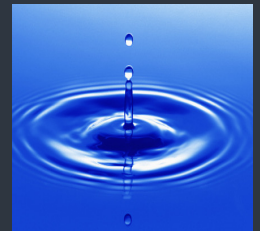




The Climate Change Impacts and Adaptation Division Presents: Climate Change Adaptation and Water 2011-12 Webinar Series
